

On Ash Wednesday this week we gathered as a faith community to celebrate the beginning of this special time of the church year, Lent. Marked with the sign of ashes on our foreheads, we were encouraged to JUST DO IT... by Father Andrew. Father challenged us to consider what we should "give up", perhaps give up being judgemental about others, or give up the grudges we hold about things that happened so long ago. He also encouraged us to consider "giving" in this time of Lent. Maybe to give something of ourselves to someone who needs it; a smile, a compliment, a reassuring hug. The season of Lent challenges us to prepare for the season of Easter, a time where we remember that Jesus gave up his life so that we may believe in who he was and what he stood for and follow in his ways.

St Justin's Primary School seeks to provide a safe, open and nurturing learning environment for all students. The school acknowledges the value that volunteers play in a variety of learning, school based and community activities and actively encourages their participation.



Thanks to all those who have already applied to be a volunteer at St Justin's and have had an interview – already we've had about 60 applicants. Following on from the successful interviews held in the last few weeks, we have opened up some more time slots over the next few weeks to conduct volunteer screening and induction procedures for any parents wishing to volunteer their services here at St Justin's. To make time for an interview, please refer to the attached instructions.

To ensure the safety and wellbeing and protection of all students, St Justin's Parish Primary School, ensures that all of our policies and practices embed a child-safe culture that has zero tolerance for child abuse. Our recruitment, screening, induction, ongoing monitoring and assessment for volunteers align with our Child Safety Policy and our Child Safety Code of Conduct and adhere to the requirements of Clause 10 of Ministerial Order No. 870 (Volunteers).

St Justin's Primary School takes its commitment to maintaining a 'child safe' environment for all students and young people seriously and implores that all members of the school community, including volunteers, work with us to achieve this.

A volunteer is defined as any unpaid individual who provides support in educational, sporting, extra curricula or school community activities to the school. Their assistance is provided under the direction and supervision of identified school representatives.

Any parent who wishes to volunteer their services to the school must ensure they participate in the school's volunteer screening and induction procedures.

All volunteers must:

- *Provide evidence (driver's license/Medicare card/passport) of personal identity*
- *Provide a valid Working with Children Check (WWCC)*
- *Respond to Volunteer Application questions*
- *Complete two Referee Reports for Volunteers that affirm that volunteer's suitability for working with children*
- *Meet with the Principal and/or Deputy Principal as part of our regular interview process. A Record of Interview will be completed at this time.*

Volunteer Packs (envelopes) were sent home a few weeks ago. Information is also available on our website, under the Child Safety tab, located under the Our Student tab.

Chicken Experts/Sustainability Helpers


