Dear Families and Friends,

St Justin's Professional Learning Days, 11th and 12th June

This week we had the privilege of spending time together as a staff to reflect on our work together as a team. Over the past few months, our leadership team has attended various regional learning days around the work of Dr Lyn Sharratt (Associate, Ontario Institute for Studies in Education, University of Toronto). This week we were able to synthesize this learning and present it to our staff team.

Lyn Sharratt's work delves deeply into the research about collaborative cultures and the benefits they have shown to outcomes for students. As a staff we examined what we can do to tighten our working culture and how a deeper emphasis on student data can assist us in further refining student instruction for students at all levels and stages of development. We investigated how holding data-rich conversations and engaging in professional learning about specific approaches can benefit our own professional practice and, in turn, student outcomes.

We took time to review specific data in the area of Mathematics and also continued our professional learning into the implementation of this curriculum area. We reviewed current practice in this area across all year levels and highlighted the elements of a Numeracy session which current research indicates supports the most comprehensive learning. As we move forward, we will continue to discuss and refine these strategies and spend time mentoring each other in specific characteristics of the Numeracy learning block.

BOOK FAIR 2019

This year's annual Book Fair will take place on <u>Thursday 20th June</u> – <u>the day of the Parent / Teacher Interviews</u>. The funds raised from the Book Fair go towards new books for our library.

The children will have an opportunity to look at and discuss the books in their library session.

From this session they will bring home a 'wish list'. Please discuss the books on their list with your child and decide together what is most appropriate for your child. The wish list is only a 'suggested list' and the choice is yours.




