St Justin's Primary School seeks to provide a safe, open and nurturing learning environment for all students. The school acknowledges the value that volunteers play in a variety of learning, school based and community activities and actively encourages their participation.

To ensure the safety and wellbeing and protection of all students, St Justin's Parish Primary School, ensures that all of our policies and practices embed a child-safe culture that has zero tolerance for child abuse. Our recruitment, screening, induction, ongoing monitoring and assessment for volunteers align with our Child Safety Policy and our Child Safety Code of Conduct and adhere to the requirements of Clause 10 of Ministerial Order No. 870 (Volunteers).

St Justin's Primary School takes its commitment to maintaining a 'child safe' environment for all students and young people seriously and implores that all members of the school community, including volunteers, work with us to achieve this.

A volunteer is defined as any unpaid individual who provides support in educational, sporting, extra curricula or school community activities to the school. Their assistance is provided under the direction and supervision of identified school representatives.

Any parent who wishes to volunteer their services to the school must ensure they participate in the school's volunteer screening and induction procedures.

All volunteers must:

- Provide evidence (driver's license/Medicare card/passport) of personal identity
- Provide a valid Working with Children Check (WWCC)
- Respond to Volunteer Application questions
- Complete two Referee Reports for Volunteers that affirm that volunteer's suitability for working with children
- Meet with the Principal and/or Deputy Principal as part of our regular interview process. A Record of Interview will be completed at this time.



The Victorian Government Guidelines for the management of Anaphylaxis in Schools sets out clear responsibilities for the parents/guardians of students which are outlined as follows:

- Notify school of their child's allergies and provide appropriate medical information
- Assist the school in the development of an Individual Anaphylaxis Management Plan for their child and participate in reviews of this plan
- Ensure that the school is notified of changes to the child's medical condition or emergency contact details
- Provide an ASCIA Action Plan for Anaphylaxis completed by the child's doctor or nurse practitioner
- Provide an adrenaline auto-injector clearly labelled with the child's name to the school.
- Provide any other medication indicated on the child's ASCIA Action Plan for Anaphylaxis and ensure that it is in date.
- Promptly replace the child's adrenaline auto injector if it is used or out of date
- Provide an updated ASCIA Action Plan for Anaphylaxis after a change in the health condition of the child, through annual reviews by a medical practitioner or after an allergic reaction
- Assist school staff in planning and preparation for the student prior to school camps, field trips, excursion or special events (eg: class parties, cultural days, fetes or sports days). Supply alternative food options for the student when needed.
- Educate the child about their allergies and how to minimise the risk of exposure (such as not sharing food if allergic to food, or taking precautions when outdoors if allergic to insects.

If you are not sure what you need to do, please consult with your child's teacher to discuss any concerns that you may have.

DRUMMING BEATS will be offered to students in Year 5 and 6 this term.


DRUMMING BEATS rehearsals will be on Thursday Lunchtimes in the PAC.


St Justin's Swimming Program

The St Justin's Swimming Program will commence on the first day of Term 2, Monday 19^{th} April and run for two weeks. This program is conducted for students in Years Prep-4. Parents wishing to support classes for this program are reminded that you will need a valid Working with Children Check and have completed an interview with either Patrick Torpey or Annie Herbison in the last two years. At this stage, we are uncertain if parent

helpers will be permitted inside the complex, however as soon as we are aware we will inform parents of the process. More information will be made available towards the end of this term.

Skoolbag - Smart Phone App

Members of our school community are invited to download our Smart Phone App. The App is used for communication between school and home – it is a portal for notifying absences, newsletters, notices and messages relevant to members of our school community.





CAMP SPORTS AND EXCURSIONS FUND

This is a Victorian Government initiative which provides payments to schools for eligible students to attend camps, sports and excursions. The amount payable for eligible primary students is \$125 and for those students this amount will be used to reduce their school fees.

To be eligible to receive the payment a parent or legal guardian of a student must on the first days of Terms 1 or 2 be an eligible beneficiary, who holds a Centrelink Health Care Card (HCC), Pensioner Concession Card (PCC) or a Veterans Affairs Gold Card, or be a temporary foster parent and submit an application to the school.

Please collect an application form from the school office, complete and return as soon as possible. Payments will be made directly to schools from March 2021. Once received, these payments will be credited to school fees.

Any parent who applied for, and received, the CSEF last year IS NOT REQUIRED to submit a new form this year.
