Dear Families and Friends,

Recently I had the pleasure of listening to Ben Crowe. Ben is one of Australia's most in-demand professional mentor and leadership coach, working with coaches, teams, CEO's and executive teams in Australia and all over the world. His work involves helping people with their mindset on the field professionally and with their perspective off the field personally, to find a balance between Confidence & Happiness, and Achievement with Fulfilment. He currently works with tennis world No 1 Ash Barty, 7 x World Surfing Champion Stephanie Gilmore, the Australian Men's and Women's Cricket teams, Dylan Alcott and with Richmond FC since 2017.

One strategy that Ben suggested to help create a sense of gratitude is to change the letter "o" in "got" to an "e" - "get". Instead of saying "I've got to go grocery shopping!" say "I get to go grocery shopping". Instead of saying "I've got to make the bed!" say "I get to make the bed." "I've got to go to work!" "I get to go to work". It certainly helps create a sense of appreciation, considering that many people in the world don't have the same opportunities or the same things that we have. Every now and then we need to stop and appreciate what we have – we have much to be thankful for.


First Communion

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First Eucharist Workshop



Premiers Reading Challenge



This year, all students in P-6 will take part in the Premier's Reading Challenge. This challenge encourages students to read a set number of books over the year and record their efforts online. Information about this was sent home to parents this week and students received their login cards. I am already so impressed with the number of books students have already read this year! (They can log in the books they have read from March). Please join in as we aim to promote and inspire a love of reading for our students!!



Kitchen Garden

On the menu this week was delicious minestrone soup served with bread, spread with homemade butter. We made butter shaking a jar of cream until the solid and liquid separated to leave us with delicious tasting and spreadable butter. It took about 10 mins for all the students to have a turn at shaking the jar until the butter formed. We used herbs from the garden in the soup and for the butter. Usually our chickens get to eat the leftovers, however the soup was so yummy that there wasn't much left for them!

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In the garden we propagated lavender cuttings planting them into newspaper pots encouraging them with a dab of honey to promote growth. They are now in the warmth and protection of the greenhouse where we hope they will take root and grow into more plants. The students understood this to be an exercise they can repeat to prevent buying new plants and reuse what we already have.



With the leftover herb leaves we will dry these out and use them to make herb sachets.



Chickens

Our chickens had a taste of freedom this week by being allowed out into an extension of their chicken run created using temporary fencing. They looked as if they enjoyed the chance to stretch their legs. Our year 4 Stewards of our School will look to create a more secure fencing arrangement so as to allow the chickens more space during the day.



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Minestrone Soup



INGREDIENTS

- 3 bacon rashers, rind removed, roughly chopped
- 2 carrots, peeled, chopped
- 2 celery sticks, chopped
- 1 desiree [potato](#), peeled, chopped
- 2 garlic cloves, crushed
- 1L (4 cups) Massel beef style liquid stock
- 400g can chopped tomatoes
- 400g can red kidney beans, rinsed, drained
- 80g (1 cup) small shell pasta
- 1/3 cup chopped fresh continental parsley

METHOD

- Step 1
Place the bacon, carrots, celery and potato in a large saucepan and stir to combine. Cook over high heat, uncovered, stirring often, for 5 minutes.
- Step 2
Add the garlic, beef stock, tomatoes and red kidney beans to the pan, cover and bring to the boil. Reduce heat to medium-low. Simmer, covered, stirring occasionally, for 30 minutes or until the vegetables are tender. (To freeze the soup, see note).
- Step 3
Increase heat to high. Add pasta and cook, uncovered, stirring occasionally, following packet directions or until pasta is al dente. Season with salt and pepper. Ladle into serving bowls and sprinkle with parsley. Serve immediately.

Marine Ambassadors



In a couple of weeks our Marine Ambassadors will be hosting visitors to our school - students from other schools as well as the leadership team from the DRI who will run peer teaching workshops. The students will gain knowledge about sea creatures and the perils they face and how we can work to protect them and generate awareness in our community.

Following that there is an excursion to Ricketts Point in Beaumaris where the students will explore the rock pools and learn about this particular water system along with the creatures that inhabit this marine environment. All their learnings will be shared back at school with students to promote awareness and suggest ways we can all contribute to a better planet.

In Week 4, students in Year 3 and 5 will be undertaking NAPLAN and many of them are starting to feel concerned and anxious about this. They are unsure what the tests will look like and ask them to do, as well as being worried that they won't do well. It is a great opportunity for teachers and parents to sit with children, listen to their concerns and offer support. It is also a wonderful chance to discuss success - what this means, what it looks like for different people and what we must do to work towards achieving success in different areas of our lives.

To succeed is to accomplish a desired aim or purpose - I think this is important to remember - it says nothing about doing well, being the best or achieving the highest score. Success is an accomplishment of a task or goal that is important to the individual.

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In primary school in particular, when students are asked to sit a 'test', it is often very hard to convince them we aren't looking for the highest score. We want to see what they can do and how much they have improved, and we want them to see this too. Tests aren't for everyone and often they are not the best measure of what a person knows, understands or can achieve, however they are a prominent part of our education system and students must be aware of this. The conversation needs to focus on students doing their absolute best, showing improvements that are positive for where they are at in their learning journey and having a positive growth mindset around having a go, not being afraid to get things wrong, learning from their errors and moving forward.

NAPLAN is a different type of test for children in its format and what it asks students to do. It is used to compare students and schools against a norm. To help students alleviate the stress and anxiety they are feeling around this, it is important for us to help them understand WE are only looking for THEIR very best effort, not their best compared to others. Encourage children to set themselves a goal - it may be as simple as answering three quarters of the questions on their Math NAPLAN paper, this may help to ease the pressure they are feeling about getting it done and getting it right.

Keeping a positive attitude and maintaining a positive growth mindset is vital during these times of added stress, for children and for adults. Keep language around NAPLAN - and all other areas of schooling - positive, acknowledge how children are feeling and keep the conversation going if that is what your child requires, and encourage students to enter into the classroom with a positive outlook for the day ahead.


